


Visually impaired dogs cope remarkably well when adapting to a new home, consistency and verbal markers are a necessity when adopting a dog who is visually impaired. They learn quick to familiarise themselves with their surroundings and family. It is often helpful if they have another dog with them as well. Karl is a lovely, kind and gentle dog who loves to be with his people getting lots of attention. Unfortunately Karl missed out on a lot of important socialisation when he was a young puppy so he has a little catching up to do. He is young, keen and ready to learn and experience new things. He will need adopters who are at home most of the time while he settles in to family life. Karl is suitable to live with other dogs and children aged 13 years and over.
